Below is a general guideline outlining a typical Canteen day:

- 9.10am Arrival and sign in at the Office
- 9.15am Open roller doors, collate orders and turn on pie warmer
- 10.00am Prepare food for morning tea and start lunch preparation
- 11.00am If time permits, have a short break
- 11.20am Serve morning tea to students
- 11.40am Wash up and hand over to second shift volunteers
- 11.50am Put food items in pie warmer and prepare lunch food
- 12.40pm Bag hot items such as chicken goujons, pizza muffins, wedges, etc. Pack lunch bags including spoons, forks etc.
- 1.10pm Students collect lunch baskets
- 1.20pm Serve students
- 1.50pm Close up shop and clean up
- 2.00pm Sign out
